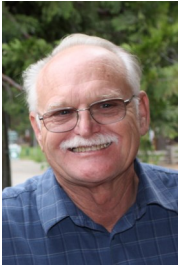

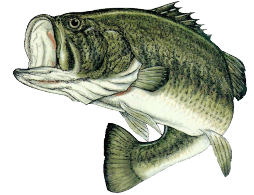

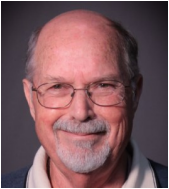
This month we have a "Team Tournament" scheduled for Collins Lake on March 17 and a "Fun Day" scheduled for Lake Berryessa on March 31.

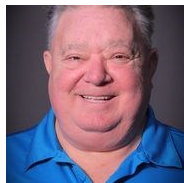

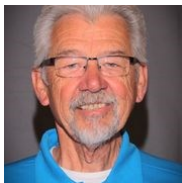
