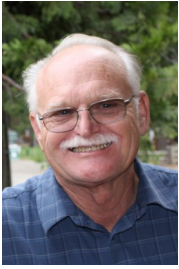

Treasurer report: Currently there is \$2039.98 in Branch 109's account and all bills are paid.



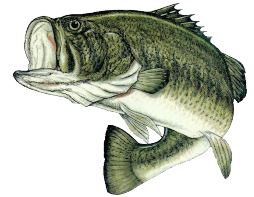

This month we have a "Fun Day" scheduled on June 15 and a "Tournament on June 29 on Lake Oroville.

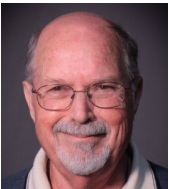
Fishing for Bass has been good at most Local Lakes.

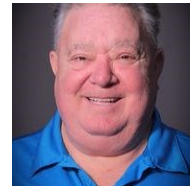


The golfing schedule is very active from March to October. There are a few tournament regulations that ensure that play is efficient and enjoyable for everyone.
