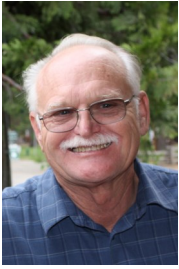

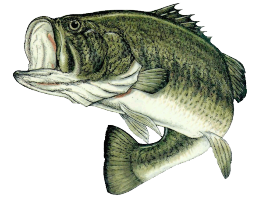

Last month we had a "Fun Day" at Camp Far West. Those that braved the high heat reported catching limits of Bass.

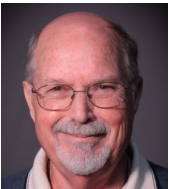

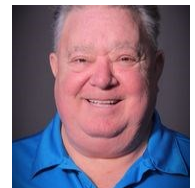


The golfing schedule is very active from March to October. There are a few tournament regulations that ensure that play is efficient and enjoyable for everyone.

We had a good turnout last month at Fernando's and we hope to do the same this month at Pete's Brewhouse.

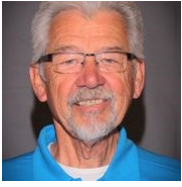
It will be Thursday August 24th at 6 pm. Pete's is located at 866 W. Onstott Rd in Yuba City.
