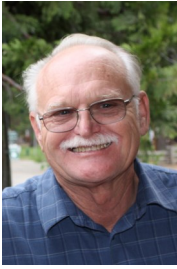

Fishing Report by Don Allen .

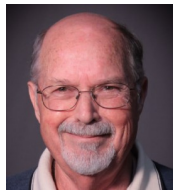
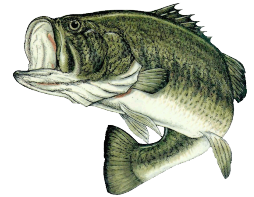

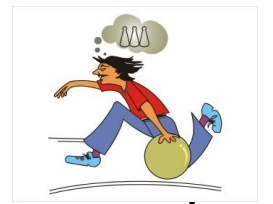


Once again Beale Bowl is open, and we are bowling every Wednesday.

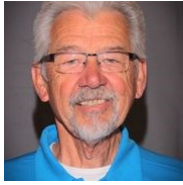
