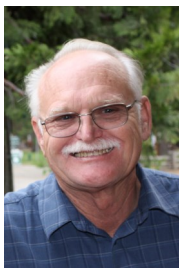

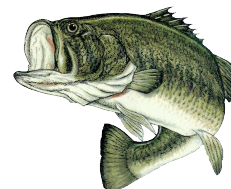

**Fishing Report by Don Allen**

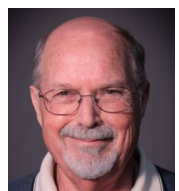


Last month we had our annual 3 day trip to Lake Shasta. Those that went had a great time catching Bass and a few Trout, plus lots of good food.

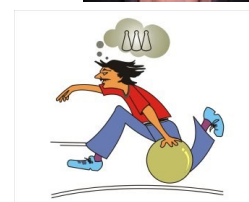

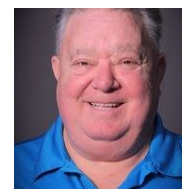


The golfing schedule is very active from March to October. There are a few tournament regulations that ensure that play is efficient and enjoyable for everyone.
