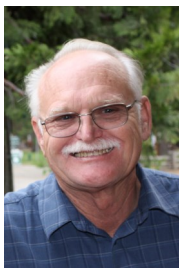
Branch 109 has \$1,118.55 currently in our checking. The 3rd quarter assessment of \$121.00 has been paid and there are no outstanding bills.

Fishing Report by Don Allen

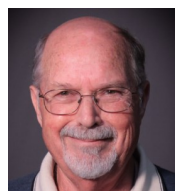
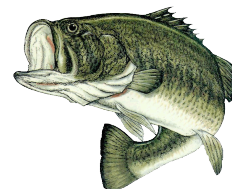
Last month we had "Fun Day" on Lake Oroville on July 17th. Six boats showed up, catching mostly Bass and a couple of Trout.

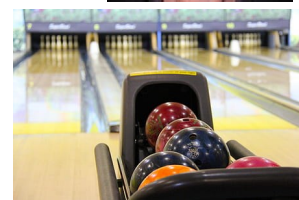

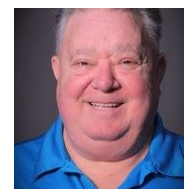


The golfing schedule is very active from March to October. There are a few tournament regulations that ensure that play is efficient and enjoyable for everyone.
