The fiscal year ends after our annual End of Year tournament on September 26<sup>th</sup>. At this time Andre Dodd (Assistant Golf Chairman) and I (Golf Chairman) have decided to end our tenure and wish to have someone else in Branch 144's golf community take over as the chairman and assistant chairman. Someone will need to step up by the end of July in order to learn how to perform the various functions and computer systems. I would prefer someone to step up even sooner.

I had announced at the last meeting that I am requiring all players to sign-up for the first tournament after our monthly meeting. The reason for this is to give those golf courses that limit the number of players an accurate count on how many players we will field.

For example: last month we played Pheasant Run. Between all the branches we were limited to 96 players. At the time of our meeting the other branches had already signed up 72 players. With the cap at 96 the result is only 24 spots were left for us. The problem is who gets left out if we have more than 24? I don't want to make the decision of who gets left out nor do I want to have to say to a member you cannot play. With the advanced knowledge the handicap chairman can then negotiate with the golf course to give us additional holes as needed.

This month our first tournament is The Reserve and we are usually capped unless we can provide an accurate number of players who are planning to play. If we get enough to sign-up in advance we can negotiate to have additional holes or even get the whole golf course and not worry about the open play they put in between our group. Please note that beginning in May the start times will be 8:00 AM. So don't be late.

Friday May 20<sup>th</sup> will be our annual visit to Turlock CC. The cost of \$60 includes a continental breakfast, golf with cart, and a full course lunch/dinner at the end. Tee time is 8:30. There will be a signup sheet at the upcoming monthly meeting/luncheon. This is a great outing for us so please help support Joe Adams on making this a successful event. I have done this since it's beginning and have not been disappointed. My golf sucked but the tournament and food was great.

On April 4<sup>th</sup> the first Match Play round was played at Creekside. Remember, were you unable to play your match on the day of the tournament and had rescheduled a makeup round with your opponent the makeup round must be completed prior to the second round scheduled for May 4<sup>th</sup> otherwise by default your opponent wins.


