When writing out your checks please be sure to include the course name and the date of the tournament in the memo part of the check. This added information is beneficial for both the Treasure and I. It eliminates confusion as to which tournament the check is for and facilitates returning checks to players for tournaments that were not played.

On the signup sheets I have been seeing requests for the same playing partners from different groups. This is confusing for me in which group to place requested players and in turn increases the amount to time it takes to fill out the signup sheets sent to the Handicap Chairman.

Each player is responsible for filling out the signup sheet completely and correctly. Talk with the players you want to play with and make sure that another group does not want to play with the same player. Duplication creates problems. Also remember handwriting need to be legible.

Starting in March when I do the Signup Sheet for the Handicap Chairman and I encounter this confusion; I may not attempt to sort out who is to play with who. If a player leaves the request off, I may not place that player in any group and the player will be placed in a random group at the discretion of the Handicap Chairman.


