Don't forget the End of Year tournament is just around the corner. It will be held on September 26th at Manteca. This will be the last tournament that both Andre and I will host. Jay Norris still needs an assistant.

Don't forget it is now a requirement to signup for the tournament following the next months meeting. All other branches hold their meetings before us and require their members to signup for the tournament after their meeting of the next month. If players from 144 do not sign up for the tournament following the next months meeting, I cannot give an accurate count to the Handicap Chairman. This could result in the situation where some players may not be able to play because of a cap placed upon us by the golf course.

Golf carts at Dryden on June 27th was a major issue. Dryden did not have enough carts. At Creekside on June 6th there were not enough carts. This resulted in the Golf Club paying an extra fee for additional carts. When signing up for tournaments at these courses be aware of this problem and consider walking instead. I know in our age group for some walking is not an option.

Lastly, playing partners. If a player does not signup at our meeting, I do not honor the request from other players to be paired with that player. As in the past, should a player know they will miss a meeting mail me your checks for all the tournaments you wish to sign up for with instructions (riding/walking and playing partner(s)) or give your checks to a friend to sign you up at the meeting. Only exception is upon verbal approval of the Golf Chairman or Assistant Golf Chairman.

The Golf Treasurer has requested that instead of returning checks for tournaments missed that he be permitted to shred them instead. With a show of hands from those present at the last monthly meeting it was agreed to allow the treasurer to shred checks instead of returning them. Check are not cashed until a player has played the tournament for which the check was written. Tournaments in which a player either is a No Show or Cancelled will have their check shredded. In the future no checks will be returned but will be shredded by the Golf Treasurer.

For those who are interested in the Reno outing Week One has been cancelled and combined with Week Two because of the lack of response. Those who signed up for Week One have been moved to Week Two.

Again I am getting incomplete information on the signup sheets especially whether a player wants to ride or walk. Remember if you leave it up to me you may not like what you get. Also when requesting playing partners I need the first initial and last name. First names alone are not sufficient. We have several members who have the same last name. If playing partner requests in the comment column is left off I assume by default that you don't have a preference of who you are paired with. It is also your responsibility to check with your requested partner whether they are playing or not and if they have request to play with someone else. I see a lot of request where the requested player did not even sign up.

As a reminder please be sure that the Ride/Walk, Check #, Amount Paid, and Comment columns are filled out and filled out correctly. Please write legibly so that your chicken scratch may be interpreted correctly.


