- SIR is always capitalized
- There are no periods between the letters
- The possessive of SIR is SIR's Some examples:
- John is a member of SIR Not SIRS
- SIR's annual meeting is held in August possessive
- Sir Refers to an individual member of SIR Some examples:
- Sir John Jones is a member of SIR Singular
- Many Sirs attended the SIR luncheon Plural
- A Sir's son attended a SIR luncheon Singular Possessive
- Some Sirs' wives attend SIR picnics Plural Possessive


