Now that we have two rounds of the Match Play completed, those who go on to the final round scheduled for June 1<sup>st</sup> at Dryden need to remember to make arrangements with their new opponent should you be unable to play your match on the day of the tournament. The makeup must be before July 7<sup>th</sup>.

The tournament on June 29<sup>th</sup> is our ABCD 4-Man Scramble date. This is a tournament within a tournament. Teams are made up using golfer indexes. A-players have an index between 0 and 17.0, B-players have an index between 17.1 and 22.0, C-players have an index between 22.1 and 27.0, and D-players have an index between 27.1 and 36.4. The May first indexes are to be used for determining player ranking.

If you do not wish to be on a qualifying team and still plan to play you will be paired into random ABCD groups and play a 4-man scramble. Those who wish to go on to the State qualifier, an additional \$5 is required. Green fees plus the prize fund (\$29 for Creekside) are still required for all players. The \$5 fee per team member is for those teams who want to participate in the Qualifier. As in the past, payment by check is preferred.

Those who makeup a team need to get their team members name to me as soon as is feasible.

Please note the July 7<sup>th</sup> tournament at Dryden is on a Tuesday.


