SPEAKER

This month`s speaker is Robert Bowlsby, the new Athlefic Director at Stanford. Bob gained a national reputation for his skill and integrity in running one of the country's most ambitious and successful Division I programs. When Stanford launched its search of a replacement for its outgoing athletic director, Ted Leland, Bowlsby`s name was at the top of the candidates` list.

Taking over in July 2006, he became only Stanford's sixth AD, directing a department comprised of 35 varsity teams, 15 men's, 19 women's, and one coed. Bowlsby oversees an annual budget of \$75 million.

Bowlsby's previous position was a 15 year stint as AD at the University of Iowa, and he served as chairman of the Division I Basketball Tournament Committee from 2003 to 2005.

Under his leader-

ship at Iowa, unprecedented success and growth of the athletic program occurred.

Prior to Iowa, he was AD at the University of Northern Iowa.

Bob is a native of Waterloo, Iowa, and received his BA at Minnesota St.-Moorhead and his MA at the University of Iowa. He, and his wife, Candice, have 4 children.
