Minutes of the Meeting of the Executive Board, June 25, 2008 BIG SIR, Fred Van Kirk,

BIG SIR, Fred Van Kirk, called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM in the Golf Pro-Shop Conference Room near Michael's at Shoreline Restaurant, 2960 N. Shoreline Blvd., Mountain View, CA. 94043
