Minutes of the Meeting of the Executive Board

SOUTHERN PENINSULA BRANCH #5 MICHAEL'S AT SHORELINE RESTAURANT Golf Pro-Shop Conference Room Minutes of the Meeting of the Executive Board May 28, 2008

BIG SIR, Fred Van Kirk, called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM in the Golf Pro-Shop Conference Room near Michael's at Shoreline Restaurant, 2960 N. Shoreline Blvd., Mountain View, CA. 94043 BIG SIR confirmed a Quorum of 6 or more officers and directors present. The Minutes of the Executive Board Meeting of March 26, 2008 were accepted as published. BIG SIR REPORT: The D and O (Directors and Officers) Insurance situation was reviewed by Big Sir, Fred Van Kirk, and discussed at length.

Insurance Committee Chairman, George Knapp presented a Resolution Concerning D & O Liability Insurance protection for Branch Officers. See Addendum #1 attached. This Resolution was discussed, finalized and adopted, MS&P.

A discussion was held, led by Parliamentarian Al Gardner, concerning the maximum number of Directors authorized for Branch #5. This was confirmed to be 6 since we have no Branch or State Regulation to the contrary. The BEC agreed, MS&P to authorize the number of Directors we may elect to be from 2 to 6.

We now have 4 Directors, as listed in the 2008 Branch Roster. After some discussion, it was determined, MS&P that we establish a Branch Regulation requiring the Travel Chairman to be designated one of our Directors. <u>SECRETARY'S REPORT: no report</u>

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u>: Treasurer, Don Harryman presented the Monthly cash report for April 30, 2008. The ending balance was \$6,506.83. Don had found and corrected a software error in the Form 28 cash report. Don submitted the correct February membership assessment and has obtained a reduction in our state dues as a result.

<u>BUDGET REPORT:</u> Ray Odell presented an Expenditures report updated as the end of March showing a projected shortfall of \$475 against the budget for year end. Printing supplies, Etc, as of that date has overrun the year's budget by \$215.43.

<u>TRAVEL REPORT:</u> (Joe Ames) Joe commented on a new State sponsored 50th Anniversary travel by buss to Reno scheduled for October 28-30, 2008. The 50th Anniversary trip was taken to Hawaii.
