Ernie Traugott "<u>Rescue in the Philippines</u> <u>Refuge from the Holocaust</u>"

Pre –World War II Manila is the backdrop for this littleknown chapter in WWII history. A high-profile group of cigar smoking poker friends, including (then) Colonel Dwight Eisenhower, devise an intricate international plan to rescue 1,300 Jews from certain death in Nazi concentration camps.

This film story is told through interviews with historians, and relatives of key players. First person accounts from survivors detail their harrowing escape from Europe and immigration to the Philippines. Our speaker and Branch 5 member, Ernie Traugott, is one of those survivors, and will be available for questions and comments at the end of the DVD showing.

## Minutes of the Meeting of the **Executive Board**

Minutes of the August 26, 2013 Branch 5 Branch Executive Committee Meeting

Meeting was called to order at 10:02 AM. A quorum was present.
