SUMMARY OF BRANCH 5 Executive Board MINUTES

November 15, 2017-10:00 AM

- **1.**The meeting was called to order at 10 AM.
- 2. There was a quorum present with eight attendees. In attendance were Chris Vasquez, Pete LoPresto, Bob Simons, Al Stratz, Paul Butler, Gary Hornberger, Roy Dreisbach, Foster Kinney, Dan Haley, Tom Donahue and Carl Orta. (attendance attached)
- **3.** The minutes were approved for October.
- 4 There were no visitors or guests. 5.Big SIR reports:

New member Phil Vollmer was inducted in November. Foster called for the membership to get to know new member Phil Vollmer. New Member Don Speck (sic) will be inducted today. He already joined us at bocce on the first Tues-

day. Both of these new members should have their contact information in the December Newsletter. Gary corrected the spelling of Don Specht and said that he would introduce Mr. Specht at today's meeting. Foster stated that he would like personal information of the new members to get into the newsletter. He would like the name and address of all roster changes for the new members.

There is a 12-page report from the Silicon Valley Institute for Regional Studies that between now and 2025 up to 300,000 workers will retire in the Silicon Valley. We offer an opportunity to socialize — "adding years to your life and life to your years." Any retirees you know, invite them to SIR. Foster introduced the article and stated that this would be a good opportunity to find new members and also for publicity.

- 6. Paul reported that he has done an analysis of the membership information and discovered that 29 of the 60 members have some kind of Lockheed affiliation. Paul stated that 3 members have Raychem affiliation there are two from Hitachi. He said that many are from the Los Altos area and he surmised that the reason is that they have friends in the area and this is how they find out

- 9. Treasurer's Report and approval Pete LoPresto reported in October we had \$806 income, \$1285.52 expenses with a loss of \$479.52. He stated that among the expenses was \$200 for unused San Francisco Giants tickets and money for postage and supplies. He stated the year to date gain was \$668.81. He said that last year at this time we had a balance of \$1536. He said this year we have \$2200. The treasurer's report was accepted. (attached)
 - 8. Committee Reports:

Attendance – Tom Donahue reported that we had 31 paid lunches last luncheon, 34 attendees including two speakers and one Guest. Foster said that he is working with a branch 35 member on the possibility of a transfer to our branch due to an accessibility issue. Foster reminded the BEC that for prospective new members we provide one free lunch as a tryout.

Membership - Paul Butler reported that we have one new member Don Specht and there is not much other activity. He also stated that he is in need of badges and we should consider buying some for next year. Foster stated that he is working on securing about 10 hats. It was agreed that the report SIR would contain 61 headcount, which will include Vollmer and Specht. (attached)

Speakers – Al Stratz reported that in January the speaker will talk about sepsis. Al reported that the name of the speaker is Kelly Nguyen. He reported that today's speaker would talk about the physics of baseball.
