TIM RYAN New 49er Radio Color Analyst

Tim Ryan has been doing color for the 49ers preseason football for the last couple of years and will now be taking over from Eric Davis as the 49er radio analyst this season.

Born in Memphis, Tennessee he became a Mercury-News all CCS selection as an offensive and defensive lineman for the Oak Grove Eagles in San Jose. Tim then went to the University of spoiled children (USC) where in 1986 he was the first freshman to start since former 49er Riki Ellison in 1978. He was two-time All-American in 1988 and 1989. Ryan is the all-time leading tackler in USC history, holds the season record for sacks with 20. The former team captain led the team to three rose bowls. He played for the Chicago Bears from 1990 through 1993 after being a 3rd round (#61) draft choice.

Ryan has been doing various sport-casting jobs for many years. He is most noted for his distinctive voice on many NFL and college games for Fox sports. He has also done sports news for Sirius XM radio.

SIRS ON BIKES: SIR Area #16 bike rides regularly start at 11:00 AM the **2nd Thursday of the month**. Wives and Guests are welcome.

Bring bike, helmet and a jacket if it is windy. Rain will cancel. Attendance averages 10-15 riders. More are welcome. Rides are planned to be 15-20 miles on paved bicycle trails (so that almost any type of bike is usable) with some optional ride distances. The pace is moderate and riding on streets is kept to a minimum and includes a restaurant lunch break

The Ride: We begin the ride at the La Avenida Trial Head and follow the Stevens Creek Trail for 1.5 miles where we connect with the Bay Trail. We continue the ride 3.5miles on the levees and old service roads as we cross the waters north of Moffett Field. *(Note: This portion of the Bay Trail has a packed gravel surface and is bumpy in places)* We then head for Sunnyvale Baylands Park where we follow the trail through the park and then to downtown Alviso, where we will have lunch at a restaurant. The ride is 9.5 miles one way. We will return on the same route for a roundtrip of 19 miles. There are no optional shortcuts.

Directions: Meet at the La Avenida Trail Head at end of La Avenida Ave. From the intersection of Hwy 101 and Shoreline Blvd,head north on Shoreline Blvd. toward the Computer Museum. La Avenida is the first street on the right, but you can't turn there as it is a one-way street. Instead go past the Computer Museum to Pear Ave; turn right. Ingo Way is the next street; turn right. La Avenida is the next St.; turn left. (It is a two-way street here). Go four blocks to the end of the street. Park on the street, next to the curb.
