# Speaker November 6th, 2013

# BILL KAMIN Iran, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan

Bill Kamin, our member since the 80's, has spent much of his time traveling the world. One of his most memorable trips was made last November to Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan and Iran. The Stans had a long history of stations along the Silk Road and prominent cities in the empire of Genghis Khan. Iran has an ancient heritage from the time of Cyrus the Great and monumental ruins like Persepolis. Kamin was able to travel through Iran despite the present animosity between our governments. Since retirement he has been making and selling photography from his travels. He will present photos from this trip, accompanied by commentary.



**SIRS ON BIKES:** SIR Area #16 bike rides regularly start at 11:00 AM the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month. Wives and Guests are welcome.

Bring bike, helmet and a jacket if it is windy. Rain will cancel. Attendance averages 10-15 riders. More are welcome. Rides are planned to be 15-20 miles on paved bicycle trails (so that almost any type of bike is usable) with some optional ride distances. The pace is moderate and riding on streets is kept to a minimum and includes a restaurant lunch break.

# October 10th Ride: Copyote Crk-Alameda Creek(Niles/Fremont)

The Ride: We will begin the ride at the Coyote Hills Park and continue on the Alameda Trail to Niles where we will have lunch at a restaurant in downtown Niles. The ride is flat and approximately 9 miles each way, with an optional loop of a scenic view of the bay that adds about one mile (a total ride of 19 miles).

Directions: Take highway 84 across the Dumbarton Bridge past the toll booth to the first exit, which is Paseo Padre Parkway. Turn left and go one mile to Paterson Ranch road; turn left. This is the entrance to Coyote Hills Park (there is a small sign). Go 1/2 mile to the park toll booth (\$5 per car or use your East Bay Regional Park District season pass). Continue another 1/2 mile over several speed bumps to the park office and museum; park there.
