<u>JOHN W. RICK</u> <u>The excavation of an Ancient</u> <u>Society in the Peru Highlands</u>

Dr. John Rick, Associate Professor of Anthropology at Stanford, focuses his research on prehistoric archaeology and anthropology of hunter-gatherers and early societies of the south-Western America and the Peruvian Andes. He currently directs the research project at the excavation at Chavin de Huantar in the high altitude Punta grasslands of Central Peru. He is also has taken on a project in Guatamala.

He will talk to us about the analytical techniques of studying ancient societies to determine how they lived and how their society developed. The Punta area in Peru had human settlement 12,000 years a go. There was a glacial period 9000 years ago. The area is particularly interesting because it deals with the earliest known human habitation of this Sierra environment of the Andes.

The importance of excavation of these old sites cannot be under-estimated. Chipped stone tools are divided into basic tools or honed into projectile points. Even "people poop" can be analyzed to determine societal mores. Other aspects are domesticated animals and art and burial customs. Dr. Rick will discuss these concepts and more.
