PEGGY McKEE is a very popular history teacher at Castilleja High School in Palo Alto. She has a particular interest in the Middle East and Russia.

She will present a compelling audio/visual presentation as she speaks about Ukraine, Crimea, and Moldavia all of which are prime areas of her years of history studies. Mrs. McKee will also supply informative hand-outs plus a computer link so we can further explore the subject.

Ukraine occupies a significant role in Russian history. Not only did it provide a warm water port for Russian ships but it also was significant in farming. The capital – Kiev - is in the interior while Odessa on the southern coast on the black sea is a common destination for cruise ships. Odessa is the home of the Potemkin steps featured in a classic 1920's silent movie. Sevastopol on the Crimean peninsula is a major Russian naval area where many Russian submarines and other navy ships are kept and maintained. Prior to Putin's recent adventures. Ukraine had an agreement allowing the Russian navy to use the port. Directly to the east across the peninsula is Yalta where agreements were reached regarding World War II settlements.
