# TOM DAY

**UberX: Private Cars as Taxis** 

A 20 or so minute talk by Tom Day.

From Burlingame to Baltimore, taxis are facing new competition. Private cars are taking rides for pay, disrupting established taxi businesses in more than 100 cities in 26 countries. This talk will describe Uber. Lvft, and the other so-called "rideshare" companies. The speaker has twelve months experience driving for Uber on the Peninsula and at Pebble Beach.

The talk describes how the new services differ from taxis. What the customer sees. What the driver sees. Insurance and regulatory issues.

The speaker graduated from Bates College in Lewiston, Maine, a cold place. One summer he drove a Checker Cab in Boston. He went on to earn an MA from the University of New Mexico in Albuquerque. Throughout his career as a software engineer in Albuquerque, Flagstaff Arizona, Phoenix (a hot place), and the Bay Area, he has maintained a balanced life, with work, bridge, choral singing, and skiing usually complimented by another interest, like photography, African wildlife, or public speaking. He lives in Sunnyvale with his wife Olga.
