Joseph Huber is a Stanford law school graduate from a small Iowa town who became a partner at a insurance defense law firm. He became a Palo Alto city councilman and served one term as mayor. He was appointed to the bench in 2000 presiding over misdemeanor and domestic violence cases. He moved to the civil division where he became supervising judge.

He is known as a calming influence in court and a judge who can separate the wheat from the chaff and cut to the bottom line.


