QUENTIN KOPP

QUENTIN KOPP was chairman of the California High Speed Rail Authority but has left the Authority because he feels that it has lost its way. Political issues and complaints by residents have led to increasing costs and grumbling about the route as well as debates regarding who will run the system if it is ever built.

Mr. Kopp – known as the great dissenter – has been a long time player in local politics. He was born in Syracuse, New york and went to Dartmouth and Harvard Law. He was a San Francisco Supervisor from 1971 to 1986 and ran for Mayor as an independent in 1979. From 1986 to 1994 he was a California state Senator. After being termed out, Governor Pete Wilson nominated him to a San Mateo County judgeship. He participated in the BART extension to SFO, and had the 380 freeway named for him. His long time support of mass transport issues led him to the chairmanship of the HSR Authority.

Being a man of many opinions we can assume he will have a bit to say about HSR.

If the parking lot there is full, backtrack over the creek to 401-501 Island Parkway and park in the Oracle lot. Ride your bike across the pedestrian bridge to the meeting point.
