Big SIR Notes:

Recently there was an area wide meeting of the SIRS leadership that was chaired by Andy Danver. Here are my notes.

Our target for new members is no longer folks who are retired. Our target marker includes folks of 60 to 70 years who have a lot of leisure time. We need to increase the visibility of SIRs. Thus, we have initiated a

pilot ad program wherein the state will match us dollar for dollar. Branches should do the marketing and every year marketing directors must indicate the nature of their effort.

There are four distinct participants in our activities.

- 1. Member (this includes the rest of his family)
- 2. Visitor (anybody who stops in to participate in an activity, but pays their own way.)
- 3. Guest (someone who has the potential to become a member, often getting a free meal out of it)
- 4. Permanent Participant (anyone who can not join but who participates in an activity on a regular basis)

The state strongly supports activity sharing with other branches. For instance, Branch 35 shares most activities with us, however you should contact the activity chairman since he may be at capacity. They make the decision at an activity level.

Branch 35 is going to initiate a push to allow women to join SIRs. There are still some obstacles in their path. They need a vote of the entire membership plus they will need to revise their charter. The charter revision will probably take place in 2026.
