April Speaker



Forney Lundy

Join us on April 10th when our guest speaker will be SIR Branch 28's own Forney Lundy. Forney will draw on his long career in air traffic control (ATC) to talk about *Air Traffic Control: Past, Present and Future.*" Since his retirement from the FAA, he has also been deeply involved with the Association of Federal Employees and Retirees.

Forney is eminently qualified to speak on the subject of ATC in the U.S. with 39 years of experience. Most of his experience was in enroute control of air traffic, but he served his last ten years as the Air Traffic Manager (Chief) of the Monterey Air Traffic Control Tower. Considering the recent spate of incidents involving commercial aircraft around the United States, Forney's insights and knowledge will give us an inside look at the ATC system, current issues, and future outlook for the system. Bring your questions about how the safety of commercial aviation travel is enhanced by the dedicated service of our professional air traffic controllers.




