The two books are Hotel Ukraine a novel by Martin Cruz Smith just published in July. It's the latest installment in the author's "celebrated Arkady Renko series, as the legendary Moscow investigator seeks to solve the murder of a diplomat as Russia's invasion of Ukraine wears on." And The Fourth Turning Is Here by Neil Howe published in 2023. He argues America is in a period of civic crisis following a pattern of past American history. The cycle of four 20 year "turnings" is moving from Highs (expansion) to Awakenings (spiritual rebellion), Unravelings (institutional collapse), and finally to the Crisis of the Fourth Turning, a time of great danger and transformation that will culminate in the early 2030's.


