## **Fishing Report for November**

Lake Amador and Comanche have been stocking regularly on a weekly basis. The bite is good at Comanche. North shore to the dam produces some nice trout, 10 to 20 feet deep on green or white jig heads with rubber tails. Works better than speedy shiners or boyants. Shore fishing is excellent. Water temperature is 57 degrees and trout are hitting power bait in the shallows. Green seems to be the best color.

Amador the bite is tough, boats are not doing well trolling. Shore fishing is good with some nice fish being caught off the dam. I saw a 12 & 16 pounder caught there last week. Weather is decent, get out and drown a worm 4.
