





At the recommendation of Steve Hatchett, we returned to Cosumnes River Preserve. Steve says, "I asked about best times for fall colors on the river, under all those magnificent cottonwoods, oaks, and maples. [I was told] the colors should be close to peak in early November. To boot, there should be lots of sandhill cranes in the area then." Nine of us participated in the planned trip, delayed a couple of days due to rain. The weather forecast was "Mostly sunny, with a high near 67." We got the "mostly sunny" sometime after noon. We set out on flat, placid water and enjoyed a leisurely three-mile paddle up-river. Trees were beginning to turn color, mostly yellow, with some red and orange supplied by vines grow-

ing into the trees. We saw a crane flying overhead. Up-river, we encountered relatively strong current and proceeded against it. Turning around to ride the current, we saw an otter, then stopped at a small beach, pulled our boats up the bank, and enjoyed fine conversation with lunch. We returned to the starting point by mid-afternoon, logging about 6.5 miles of paddling.

In December, we will return to our normal "First Tuesday" for scheduled outings. That will be Pearl Harbor Day of Remembrance, the 7<sup>th</sup> of December. Several sites are under consideration. We may return to our closest place to paddle, Lake Del Valle, always a good choice.




