

I heard from 14 SIR Kayakers regarding our February 1st outing to Elkhorn Slough. However, only two of us were committed to participate, with a couple more "maybes" who did not make it. This will let those interested in kayaking know what a great trip you missed!

There was a new moon, where the sun and moon are aligned on the same side of planet Earth, resulting in an exceptionally high tide. I think it was higher than the predicted 6.5 feet. I have never seen such a high tide at Elkhorn! The slough was incredibly wide, almost an inland sea. The water was on the edge of the parking lot at our launch spot. No muddy feet at launch this time! We launched IN the parking lot, paddling over the tire barriers at the lot edge.





We kayaked in places I had never been before, over fences and past "no trespassing" and "no shooting" signs along grassy hillsides, at least two feet above usual the pickle weed swamp that covers a wide swath on the north side of the slough. I occasionally detected the deeper water of side channels through the area. Within sight of the Highway 1 bridge, we returned to the main channel and proceeded to Moss Landing Harbor for lunch.

We had a fine lunch at Phil's Fish Market and Eatery in Moss Landing. After lunch, we met the still-ebbing tide, coupled with a moderately strong breeze that made the return trip a bit of a chore. We saw lots of sea birds and otters, one of which kept us company for more than a mile. We arrived back at our starting point about an hour before low tide. I eye-balled the height of the morning's high-water mark from the water's edge, estimating the height at 7-8 feet. It was a great day in the company of my co-leader, Doug Mansur.

Our next scheduled outing will be the first Tuesday of March, the 1st. The plan is to go to Discovery Bay. Being just a bit more than 20 miles from Livermore, we hope and expect a larger group. In April, likely we will go to Lake del Valle, only 8 miles from Livermore. After that, we will possibly paddle in the northern reaches of San Francisco Bay.

Ask Dick about plans for an "Introduction to Kayaking" course at Lake Del Valle for those new to the sport or wishing to upgrade their skills. Topics covered will be efficient forward stroke, boat control utilizing other strokes, edging, sculling, and capsize recovery.

We welcome new participants. It is a great sport, giving access to places otherwise inaccessible and unseen from land. I say, "A day on the water is a great day!" If you try it, I think you will agree.


