The computer is now back up, so we shall be at Lake Del Valle on Tuesday, April 12th at 9:30 AM. Thanks for the opportunity to post pictures of our re-scheduled kayak outing to Lake Del Valle. April 14 Sad to say, the event did not take place, due to predicted wind that at best would have made the trip unpleasant, and at worst, dangerous. It is re-scheduled for May 3rd.



Our Motto: Remember, there's no such thing as bad hiking weather, just inappropriate clothing.


