Speaker's Preview

July 26, 2022—Tom Ramos - LLNL "Nuclear Threats in 1961 re: Berlin"

Born and raised in Brooklyn, New York, Tom graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York. He served in the Army for twelve years before becoming a physicist at the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory. For ten years he was a nuclear weapons designer and then took an assignment at the Pentagon. Upon returning to the Laboratory, Tom created a counterproliferation program and led it for seventeen years. Ten years ago, Tom began research on the history of the Laboratory's nuclear weapons program.




Hiking is a SIR 101 Approved Activity.


