
We plan to be back on the courts on January 12 and 26, and February 9 and 23, if the weather permits. A few days before each scheduled game, a reminder email is sent





I have an update on our Croatia & Its Islands SIR trip. Our yacht got over booked and rather than Collette kicking off a bunch of other folks we got the option to leave exactly one week earlier and have the whole yacht to ourselves. We all decided to go a week earlier, now leaving on September 24 and returning October 7, 2023. The itinerary is exactly the same and we will be traveling on a new yacht that set sail in 2021. It has 18 cabins (for 36 people) and we currently have 14 cabins booked (28 people). That means we can fill four more cabins (up to 8 people) or sail with 4 vacant cabins. What is the Green Dot Program? (Editor's note: the Green Dot program continues to recognize recent new members. Nov, 2021:The Luncheon benefit is available again for 'in person' meetings.

Each member is assigned an identification number that appears on his lapel badge which is filed in numerical order near the Luncheon Meeting entrance. He will wear his badge at all meetings and must leave it when he departs the meeting. For about the first six months after he joins SIR 101, his badge will have a **Green Dot** on it which signifies he is a new member and entitles members who share his dining table, early access to the buffet line. The main purpose is to encourage members to introduce themselves to the new members and help them feel comfortable and learn what SIR is all about. The badges also provide a means of noting meeting attendance.
