The world of weather and climate modeling Ron Baskett, Certified Consulting Meteorologist February 16, 2023

The meteorology community has made great advances in the last several decades to improve the accuracy of both weather and climate modeling. Ron will show the innovations of today's weather enterprise:

- Integrated observations to initialize and nudge model runs
- Improved physics for seamless multiscale modeling from minutes to seasons
- Supercomputer advancement provides for finer model resolution

He will illustrate these advancements associated with example forecasts and discuss current research for continued improvement.



SIR 101 member Ron Baskett, a Certified Consulting Meteorologist, holds B.S. and M.S. degrees in Atmospheric Science from UC Davis. He retired in 2017 as Deputy Division Leader in Atmospheric, Earth, and Energy Division at Lawrence Livermore National Lab. His career focused on developing and applying modeling systems to predict consequences from releases of hazardous material to the atmosphere. Currently Ron leads the Tri-Valley Air Quality Community Alliance, a state-funded project to encourage actions which improve local air quality.

SIR 101 members play bocce every second and fourth Thursday of the month at Bothwell Park at Eighth and H Streets in Livermore when it is not wet and/or raining.






