
The Big Sir Message from Bob Johnson

Our Motto: Remember, there's no such thing as bad hiking weather, just inappropriate clothing.













There have been many articles on withdrawal rates or other approaches to drawing down retirement assets. I will send out a couple of articles on this topic as a pre-reading for a discussion on this topic. I believe sequence risk is a subject that every retiree should be aware of and have a strategy to mitigate it.

Definition (ChatGPT, 8/10/25):

From a retiree's perspective, **sequence risk** (or sequence-of-returns risk) is the danger that you experience poor investment returns early in retirement, when you're also making withdrawals. Even if your average return over time is decent, early losses combined with withdrawals can shrink your portfolio so much that it may never recover, increasing the risk of running out of money later.

It's basically the bad-luck timing risk of the market turning down right when you start living off your savings.
