SPELLACY'S SPOTLIGHT

This month's "Spotlight" falls on Nick Capachi, Sir # 113. Nick and I had an interesting conversation after the Branch 112 Meeting on September 7 at the Rancho Cordova Elk's Club.

Ed: Where do you hail from, Nick?

Nick: I'm a native of Sacramento, and I played shortstop on the Sacramento High baseball team. I went to play for Sacramento City College, and we won the State Championship in 1953. I was drafted into the US Army in 1956 and assigned to the "Presidio" in San Francisco, where I was able to play on service baseball teams against college teams in the Bay Area. I feel that if I had gone into baseball, I could have at least made "Triple A", since I always hit over .300.

Ed: What was your career choice after your Army service?

Nick: I got into the highway construction field and worked for Teichert Construction for 25 years, from 1969 to 1994. I worked on extension of Highway 50 from 58th Street to Sunrise Blvd, and Business 80 from Sacramento to Roseville, among many other projects. I used my experience to author a 360 page textbook in 1989 "Excavating and Grinding", which included many drawings and photos.

Ed: I've noticed a sign on Highway 50 in Kyburz called "Capachi Drive". What's the story on that?

Nick: Back in 1982, my brother-in law and I built a family cabin along the American River in Kyburz, and we put up the "Capachi Drive" sign there. Even though we're close to the river, that property has never been flooded, even in rainy years like we just had.

Ed: I know you're active in our Sirs golf group, Tell us about your golf game.

Nick: I enjoy the game and the camaraderie very much as we play a wide variety of courses in the Sacramento region. One of my golf highlights was several years ago when I made two "holes in ones" in on month. They say they sometimes come in bunches!

Ed: How long have you been a member of Sirs?

Nick: I joined the Branch back in the mid 90s' when they met at the Shepherder Inn and had a waiting list to get in. I've made many great friends over the years, and I enjoy not only the golf activities, but the luncheons and guest speakers. I'm looking forward to playing Empire Ranch on this coming Monday with my Sirs golfing friends.
