


WILLIAM (BILL) ROBERT REID January 1, 1935 - August 15, 2022

Branch 113 has lost an outstanding friend and active supporter with the passing of SIR Honorary Life Member Bill Reed. During Bill's 24 years at SIR Branch 113, he was Big SIR in 2006 and 2007, Chairman of the Christmas Party and Summer Picnic for 16 years, Chairman of the Nominating Committee for 5 years, the first Branch Champion of our Bowling Tournament in 2013, and member of the Branch Executive Committee for 6 years. Bill died peacefully at home with his family at his side.

Bill was born in Oakland, CA, the first child of Lucile and Robert Reid. His brother Dennis joined the family eight years later. He graduated from Fremont High School in Oakland in January 1954 and became a lifetime member of the Reunion Committee. He only missed one meeting (due to a Doctor's appointment) and was elected Chairman at that meeting. He graduated from the University of San Francisco with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration while serving eight years (6 months Active Duty) with the Army Reserve.

Bill had two daughters, Karen and Kelly with his first wife Nancy and was divorced while the girls were young. A few years later he met Sandy while working at FMC in Santa Clara and their commitment to each other lasted 41 years. They lived in Santa Clara while Sandy's son Greg finished school. Kelly came to live with them when she was 16 years old and finished High School.

In 1993 the children moved out and Bill retired. He and Sandy relocated to Pollock Pines and Bill became active with the SIR Organization. Sandy said he was in his element planning and organizing events and making strong friendships for 29 years. Bill was a sports expert in football, baseball, basketball and golf with bowling as he primary hobby. Sandy said he was very proud to be awarded the SIR Honorary Life Member certificate in 2012.



Bill is survived by his wife Sandy; brother Dennis and his wife Wendy and their daughters Lisa, Amy, and Becky; daughters Kelly and husband Tom and children Jack and Emma; and Karen with her daughter Chantelle; and stepson Greg and his wife Emily and their children Clara and Ben. Bill had a very close relationship with his children and grandchildren.


