New Business: Sir Jay S. announced that he and Sir Chuck .were starting a Catta Verdara parking shuttle service. Members can call ahead to arrange to get a ride from their car to the venue, since it can be a very long walk between the parking lot and the venue. Members may then get a ride back to their cars after the luncheon. Both are to be commended for their initiative in setting up this service.

Sir Jay S. spoke with Dan Guiles at Sun City Lincoln Hills about using Meridians as an alternative to Catta Verdara. There are pros and cons to Meridians, but one historical roadblock was the inability for Meridians to guarantee us the same day every month. Sir Jay found out that
