





### March 2024 Speaker, Brad DeSoto

In March 2023, Joyce DeSoto received a phone call from the US Air Force that changed their lives forever. Concerning her husband, Ernest DeSoto who was an Air Force Fighter Pilot, and assigned to Vietnam in 1969. After 54 years of waiting, Ernest's remains were positively identified and returned here to his home, this past June. 1969 on a mission, Ernest's plane was under heavy hostile attack, and then disappeared. Both he and his navigator were listed as Missing In Action. The family never knew what happened to him until last year.

Col. Ernest DeSoto was born in San Francisco, 1931. He graduated from Balboa High School, and later married his high school sweetheart, Joyce Agnone. This brave woman raised three children alone.

Her son Brad DeSoto will be sharing their story of this journey. Brad Graduated from the University of San Francisco, and holds an MBA from Northwestern University and lives in Burlingame.
