Message from Big Sir Anthony Butera



Hello fellow SIR Members, 2020 is soon to be over. Perhaps some of you would just wish the COVID 19 would just disappear. In the meantime, it might be best to stay at home or if one should

go out in the world consider wearing a mask. But there are at least four reasons why staying home makes sense.

Technology has helped make life tolerable in the pandemic. And whenever it becomes normal again to leave the house for work, school and shopping, we won't be going back to the way it was. What were conveniences before the pandemic now seem necessities that we're unlikely to give up even after there's widespread immunity to the coronavirus. And there are a number of reasons this new stay-athome economy will likely be an important part of the new normal.

First, companies have made huge investments in the infrastructure needed to deliver goods and services to our homes quickly and efficiently, which means those products are now easier to use and often less expensive. Second, families have also invested in the services and gadgets to keep their members safe and sated while sheltering in place. Third, our habits have changed: Many people have gotten over the "hump" of adopting technologies earlier than they otherwise might have. And finally, hundreds of thousands of Americans who lost traditional jobs in retail and service—on showroom floors and inside restaurants—have found new ones working in online order fulfillment and delivery. Even those who retained their jobs are seeing their roles shift to address these new conduits for economic activity.

It's no wonder Fed Chairman Jerome Powell said, "We're not going back to the same economy—we're recovering, but to a different economy."
