## Message from Big Sir Biff Galbraith



June 6<sup>th</sup>, 1944. D-Day, the largest amphibious landing in history, began as Allied forces landed in Normandy, France. Operation Overlord took months of

planning and involved 1.5 million soldiers in 47 divisions along with 4,400 ships and landing craft, and more than 11,000 aircraft. The Germans had about 60 divisions spread along France. American forces landed on two western beaches, Utah, and Omaha. British and Canadians landed father east on Gold, Juno, and Sword beaches. By the end of the first day, 150,000 allied soldiers and their accompanying vehicles had landed with 15,000 killed or wounded.

I will never stop being amazed that so many young men and women served for this country, and the high price that was paid for future generations to live in freedom and comfort. Thank you to all who have served, and we must never forget those that paid the highest price with their lives.

I am pleased that our mayor, Sue Zwahlen will speak at our June 16<sup>th</sup>, luncheon. She has been active in our community and having served on the Modesto City School Board. She worked for 38 years as a nurse and has raised 6 children. She is going to talk about her vision for Modesto, and where we are headed.

This month I am proud to select Vince Sereno as my Big SIR pick of the month. Vince has been active in our branch and has run the dining groups since 2008. Vince is taking a step back and will run for Director when Jim Toepfer becomes the new Secretary.
