Message from Big Sir Fernando Gonzalez



One of my goals as your new Big Sir is to keep you informed about the health of our branch and any issues we may be facing. The State Sir asked for the board to vote last month whether we were open to allowing

women to join in our branch and report the results back to State. The vote was most of the board voted not to allow women to join our branch.

At the board meeting we discussed the branch finances and bringing back the free birthday lunch was only going to cost \$23 for 8 months. We have kept our bank balance for the past year around \$5,000 to cover the lunch cost until the cater cashes the check plus state board assessments and any operating expenses we encounter within the branch.

Costs are an issue not just in the branch but at state level. In the past years the State Sir had fixed costs around 50k and though assessments and other revenue generated about 108k, today fixed expenses are expected to be 63k and revenue 78k.

Branches are having trouble with their costs and dwindling membership to the point that Branch 169, 175 and 179 merged into one Branch 169.

We are facing some cost issues; our lunches are \$23 but that does not include the \$1.84 sales tax. We also guarantee the catered 65 lunches. We are experiencing around 60. So, every month we are losing about \$234.60 for the end of the year we would reduce our bank balance by \$1892 and we would be operating with about \$3000 in our bank account. The other Modesto SIR branch with fewer members then ours keeps a balance of around \$5,000. Checking with other branches, they keep from \$5,000 to \$8,000 with some of the larger branches having upwards of \$10,000.

We will continue to discuss this at our board meetings but please remember this is your branch and we need your opinions, involvement, and ideas on how to keep your branch active and financially healthy.
