## March Speaker

#### Dr. Ed Sherman

Topic: Medicine, Pharmaceuticals, and Aging

Dr. Ed Sherman is an adjunct professor for the University of the Pacific's Thomas J. Longs School of Pharmacy and Health Sciences. Earning his Doctor of Pharmacy from the University of Southern California in 1963, Dr. Sherman spent the next 30 years practicing different aspects of Pharmacy until his retirement as an independent pharmacist. Following his retirement. Dr. Sherman was asked to initiate a class at UOP for student pharmacists interested expanding their views of independent business and entrepreneurship. Dr. Sherman's class is still taught as an elective at UOP with over 450 students completing the course within the last 22 years. A number of these students now own and operate their own independent pharmacies and other entrepreneurial businesses.

In addition to teaching and operating his own 340B consulting business, Dr. Sherman is active in NCPA, the California Pharmacist Association as State Treasurer, his local pharmacy association and APhA. Free time will find him at any baseball game or traveling the world. Currently Dr. Sherman resides in Stockton with his wife Sheila who he has been happily married to for over 56 years.
