Big Sir NOVEMBER Remarks

Gentlemen,

The BEC voted to keep annual dues at \$20 for 2024. Our normal monthly expenses include the newsletters, speaker lunches, guest lunches, and desserts. We also earn a few hundred dollars from the annual picnic raffle. The BEC will review the dues level again next Fall. We do not want to be collecting 2024 dues until January. Easier to track that way.

On October 12th, the State Treasurer informed all Branches that SIR State annual dues are increasing for 2024 from \$8 to \$10 per member to be paid at the rate of \$2.50 per quarter.

At the October meeting, our speaker informed us of an opportunity to learn more about recognizing and reporting human trafficking. For November our speakers will talk to us about suicide prevention. Suicide rates have been increasing (the pandemic didn't help) and rates for older men are higher than for other age groups. This topic was suggested to me quite some time ago and I was finally successful at securing three local experts. I expect it will be very interesting.

My recent Policies and Procedures review made us aware of a need to update our member induction wording. We drafted an update and the BEC approved it on October 10th. The first sections were not changed – still crowing about the majesty of the rooster – but the final section now reads as follows.

"As a member of SIR, we count on you to be a friendly sociable guy; attend our activities, luncheons and events; participate in Branch operations (as your interests and capabilities

allow); and bring guests to perpetuate and enhance the diversity of our Branch."
