He earned political science and economics undergraduate degrees from Stanford University and a joint MBA/MPP from Harvard Business School and the Kennedy School of Government. (MPP is Master of Public Policy.)

Following a few years working in venture capital, Representative Harder returned to Turlock and was elected to the House of Representatives in 2018. Representative Harder was reelected in 2020 and 2022.
