NEWS FLASH! THE DATE LOCATION FOR THE 2024 LADIES DAY PICNIC HAS CHANGED. THE NEW DATE IS JULY 16,2024 AND IT WILL BE HELD AT THE ELKS LODGE INSTEAD OF CHARDONNAY GOLF COURSE. MARK YOUR CALENDAR NOW SO YOU DON'T FORGET. I WILL EXPLAIN BELOW.

A new management company took over the Chardonnay Golf course and many of the discounts we were provided in previous years were taken away. The proposed cost increased by 30% to a total of over \$10,400 and would have resulted in a ticket price over \$65 a person which was untenable.

We contacted Elks Lodge management and because of our longterm relationship with them were able to negotiate a significantly better contract. They can provide us with a very similar meal, including both tri tip steak and BBQ chicken with all the fixings at a ticket price of \$40 a person which is \$10 less than last year at Chardonnay. It will still include bingo, raffle prizes, wine and beer all for \$40.

April guest speaker is one of the colorful characters from Napa - Gordon Huether


Some of you may already be familiar with him and the art that he has created over the years.






