On April 22, 1991, the Sons In Retirement Charter for Lake Tahoe Branch 160 was granted by SIR State.

The State organization and each of the Branches are incorporated under, and regulated pursuant to, the laws of the State of California as a nonprofit, public benefit corporation organized and operated exclusively for social welfare purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Supervision of Branches is effected through State and Branch Bylaws adopted by the membership and by Standing Rules promulgated by the State Board of Directors.
