Location: 515 N Nevada St, Carson City, NV 89703. It's 2 blocks west of the Nugget Casino, for those of you that know Carson City


Parking: There is no parking lot, so parking is on the street. Be aware that there are a couple of streets blocks that are marked as "Resident Parking Only".
