My Fellow SIR Members,

However, the large, intense fires, like the Dixie and Caldor fires last year, virtually sterilize the ground making it much more difficult for plants and animals to return.

Our June Speakers will be from Sacramento chapter of the Tuskegee Airmen Heritage. They are Lanelle Roberts Brent and Leigh Roberts, daughters of one of the first Tuskegee Airmen, George S. "Spanky" Roberts. The title of their talk is "Tuskegee Airmen History". If you have not seen the movie "Red Tails" you might want to watch it. It will give you a little insight into what the Tuskegee Airmen were all about.

Keep up the good work on bringing in new members. New members are what keeps our Branch thriving. Remember, first time guest gets a lunch on us!! Also, the Branch works because members volunteer to help. We have a Nomination committee now looking for Officers and Assistants for next year.
