SIR 1st Quarter 2024 Assessment

Fellow SIR;

Your 1st quarter assessment is due by January 15th. There are two major changes in the Assessment for 2024.

Assessment Rate Increase - The assessment rate will be increased by 50 cents per member per quarter to \$2.50. Why? In today's dollars, your assessment rate has remained almost unchanged since 2017, yet the total SIR members have dropped about 30%. As a result, SIR State has effectively absorbed almost all the losses in assessment due to having fewer members. In 2017, adjusted for inflation, the State's discretionary budget was \$72,000. In 2023 our budget was \$14,000. This has prevented the State from effectively supporting the branch, conducting training, recruiting, etc., things necessary to keep SIR a vital organization.

Your Assessment is Fixed for all Quarters - Unlike past years, this year the amount of your assessment will not be adjusted each quarter. All four-quarter assessments will be the same as the 1st quarter. So, if you increase your membership your assessment will not increase, by the same measure, if you lose members, your assessment will not decrease. So, the more members you recruit the better off you will be.

Member retention and recruitment is extremely important to keep SIRs viable!
