We've had great turn outs for our SIR Golf Tournaments so far this Summer, and we've played some fun games: Scramble, 2-Man Cha Cha, 3-2-1, and the Individual Stroke Play tournaments for the Club Championship and Heidemann Cup.

Congratulation to Richard Pike for winning the coveted Heidemann Cup at Silver Oak!

Coming up in August and September we'll have Apple Mountain Scramble, Lake Tahoe 4-Man 2 Best Ball, Carson Valley 2-Man Shamble, Toiyabe Cha Cha Cha, and Wolf Run Lone Ranger.

I'm asking players to try their best to commit to playing tournaments by the Friday before. Although BlueGolf simplifies making changes to the roster, cart assignments, and scorecards, I'd like to avoid having to send updated files the day before the event if possible.

Slow play continues to be a problem at some of our events. I'm kind of at a loss as to what to do about it. I've sent out guidelines and tips, and still groups are taking five hours and more to play. One group can hold up the entire field. We've had members threatening to quit due to slow play. I asked the Dayton Valley pro shop to send out a marshal on August 11th, but that didn't seem to help much. Short of asking a non-playing member to act as a High Plains Drifter-type marshal or penalizing players, I don't know where to go next. I know this is a universal problem, but that doesn't mean it's acceptable. And I realize when there is more than one tournament going on pace may just be out of our control. So please don't be shy about gently reminding your pairing to keep up with the group ahead of you. All this being said, if it's not cold and windy and you're playing with your pals, try to enjoy the course, the company, and the game.

I'm looking at trying a match play tournament as a one-day event. We would ante a bit more, but pay half the field. I welcome your thoughts on this.
